

# Caledon murder probe extends to Dufferin

An eight-month investigation into the murder of Ariel Besley in Caledon last May has now been broadened to include Orangeville and Shelburne, as well as Hamilton, Owen Sound and other areas.

Police say the 18-year-old Brampton man was shot to death. His body was found beside Old School Road on May 15, 2008.

Peel Regional Police arrested Roy Terrence Rousseau, 23, on May 25 during a foot pursuit off Bovard Dr., Brampton, after he fired at them with the illegally imported gun used to kill Mr. Besley.

The Peel officers returned fire and wounded Mr. Rousseau before arresting him and charging him with seven weapons-related offences, including

one of possession contrary to a court order, and another of carrying a loaded, prohibited or restricted weapon. He is also charged with possession of property obtained by crime. The circumstances of the 8 a.m. arrest of Mr. Rousseau are being investigated by the Special Investigations Unit.

OPP Constable Sherry Thompson at Bolton had no information with respect to possible charges in connection with Mr. Besley's death. But Peel police said any such charges would be laid by the OPP. "It's their case," said a media relations officer Monday.

Const. Thompson was unable to shed light on why the investigation had been extended, except to say that the OPP officers are "following leads."

Mr. Besley is not believed to be connected in any way to the Shelburne family.

# County, Mono to mull broadband jointly

County council is expected tonight to apply for a second round of Connecting Dufferin funding to extend broadband internet services to most of the rural areas that weren't connected in the first round.

The areas without service are largely in the hilly terrain of the county, such as Mono and Mulmur, where wireless is not a practical option, and Mono has been quietly planning its own separate application for funding under the same program.

In fact, says Mayor Lorie Haddock, Mono has been working toward a wired solution on and off for the past eight years, and closely with Bell Alliant official Pete Renshaw in recent months. She said the county's initial application (in October 2007) was based largely on background

developed by Mono.

The mayor considers there's urgency to the Town's application, and does not consider there's a conflict with two coincident applications being filed from within the same county.

Mono residents have long been awaiting access to high-speed internet. "It's one of the biggest bones of contention." She added that the consultants have discussed the coincidence of applications with the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) and the ministry appears to understand the necessity.

In a report to be considered by the council tonight,

#### GAS FRANCHISE APPROVAL FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST GARAFRAXA

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (the "Applicant") has filed an application dated December 4, 2008 with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") under section 9 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended (the "Act"), for an order of the Board approving the terms and conditions upon which and the period for which the Corporation of the Township of East Garafraxa (the "Corporation") is, by by-law, to grant to the Applicant the right to construct and operate works for the distribution of gas and the right to extend and add to the works in the Township of East Garafraxa. The Applicant has also applied for an order of the Board declaring and directing that the assent of the municipal electors to the by-law is not necessary.

The Board has assigned the following file number to this matter EB-2008-0391.

The application will be decided by the Manager, Facilities Applications, who has been delegated this authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). The Manager, Facilities Applications does not intend to provide for an award of costs when deciding this application.

Copies of the application and pre-filed evidence will be available for public inspection at the Board's offices, the Applicant's offices, and at the office of the Corporation at the addresses indicated below.

The Board intends to proceed with the application by way of a written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board within **7 days** of the publication date of this Notice.

If you wish to participate in the written hearing, you must forward three copies of your written submissions to the Board Secretary and one copy to the applicant at the addresses below. All submissions must be received no later than **14 days** after the publication date of this Notice. If the Applicant wishes to respond to the written submissions, such response must be received by the Board no later than **21 days** after the publication date of this Notice. All submissions must quote file no. EB-2008-0391, clearly state the sender's name and address, and be received by the Board Secretary by 4:45 p.m. on the required dates.
